

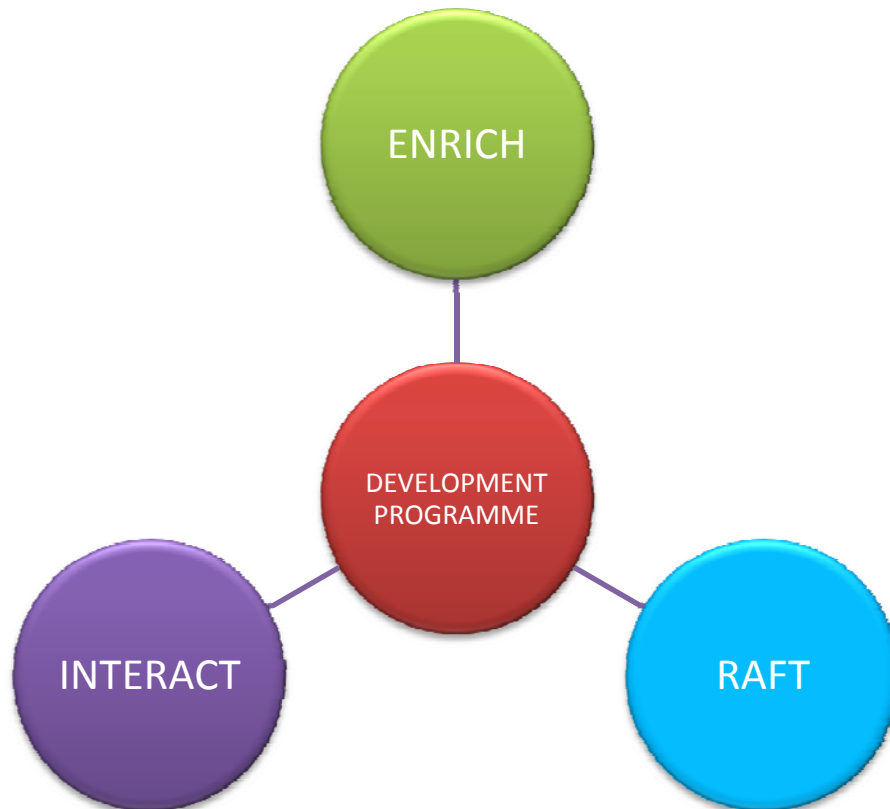

INTERACT

- Leadership & coordination: DeNDRoN local leadership and management that is linked in to local NHS clinical leadership and management; regional leadership and management of implementation of National Dementia Strategy; and national DeNDRoN support networks
- Integrated research networks: Clear and simple local processes, coordinated between CLRNs and DeNDRoN LRNs for planning and delivering NHS Support infrastructure for DeNDRoN portfolio studies that is linked into national coordination
- Research embedded in patient care: A plan which show how DeNDRoN will have the capacity, systems and support in place to enable local clinical services to signpost patients to research and allow patients to give prospective consent to be contacted about future research
- Patient, carer & public involvement: Local arrangements for active patient and public involvement in research that is integrated with local PPI arrangements in NHS trusts and local voluntary groups

ENRICH

- Thee objectives:
 1. Agreement on funding sources for the different component of research in care homes
 2. A tool kit to support researchers developing and delivering research in care homes
 3. A network of “research enabled” care homes
- Plans still emerging and developing

RAFT

- Phase 1 – to achieve a consensus on the business case, potential solution(s) and delivery mechanism(s) for the creation of a federation of local registers of patients interest to participate in research, or equivalent.
